

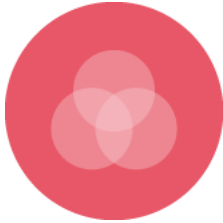

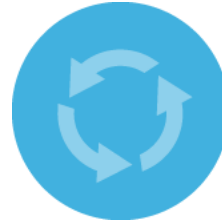

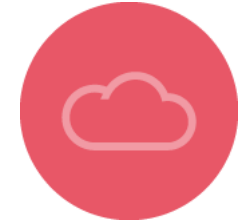
Increasingly mixed physical, virtual & cloud environments (“Triple-Play”)



Continued exponential data growth (Unstructured & structured)



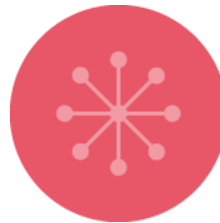
Emphasis shifting away from backup to restore and towards “Continuous availability”
